New in Research and Innovation

Jessica L. Bienstock et al published, "Postpartum Hemorrhage" in N Engl J Med in April 2021 ([link](#))

Prompt identification of patients who are at risk for postpartum hemorrhage, routine active management of the third stage of labor, expeditious assessment of blood loss, appropriate patient monitoring, and management of postpartum hemorrhage are important.

Zoe Kane et al published, "Physiologically based modelling of tranexamic acid pharmacokinetics following intravenous, intramuscular, sub-cutaneous and oral administration in healthy volunteers" in Eur J Pharm Sci. June 2021 ([link](#))

This study indicates that intramuscular administration is the non-intravenous route of administration with the most potential for achieving targeted TXA exposures.

Amy Hough et al published, "Stillbirths and neonatal deaths among 18 942 women with postpartum hemorrhage: Analysis of perinatal outcomes in the WOMAN trial" in Int J Gynaecol Obstet April 2021 ([link](#))

Women with PPH experience an extremely high rate of stillbirth and slightly elevated PDNM, which is associated with markers of the severity of their condition and impacts on their QoL.
